## Ephesians 4:4-5

- Baptism is from the Greek word "baptizo" which means a **burial, immersion**.
- Ephesians 4:4-5 – "There is . . . one baptism."

### Acts 22:16

"And now why are you waiting? Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord"

### Galatians 3:27

"For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ."

### 1 Peter 3:21

"The like figure whereunto baptism does also save us . . ."
