CHRIST

CHRIST **DIED** ON THE CROSS



CHRIST WAS **BURIED** IN THE TOMB THAT BELONGED TO JOSEPH OF ARIMATHEA



CHRIST WAS **RESURRECTED** EARLY ON SUNDAY MORNING

ROMANS 6:3-5

3 Or do you not know that as many of us as were **BAPTIZED** into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death?

4 Therefore we were **BURIED** with Him through **BAPTISM** into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in **NEWNESS** of life.

5 For if we have been **PLANTED** together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be in the **LIKENESS** of His resurrection.

OBEDIENCE TODAY

In rendering obedience to the Gospel, spiritually speaking, we emulate the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ.

ONE DIES TO SIN THROUGH REPENTANCE

ONE IS BURIED (immersed) WITH CHRIST IN BAPTISM

ONE RISES FROM THE WATERY GRAVE TO WALK IN NEWNESS OF LIFE

NOTE: ONE MUST BE BURIED WITH CHRIST (BAPTISM) IN ORDER TO BE RAISED WITH HIM
